Promotion to the next grade level:

- ❖ **Grade 9 to 10**: Requires a minimum of 5 credits, 1 credit MUST be English 9
- ❖ **Grade 10 to 11**: Requires a minimum of 11 credits, 2 of which MUST be English 9 and 10
- ❖ **Grade 11 to 12**: Requires 17 credits

Graduation Requirements

- 1. Earn 23 ½ credits
- 2. Complete a Pathway
- 3. Complete Service Learning Hours (75 hours)
- 4. Pass end of course exams – HSAs & MCAP assessments

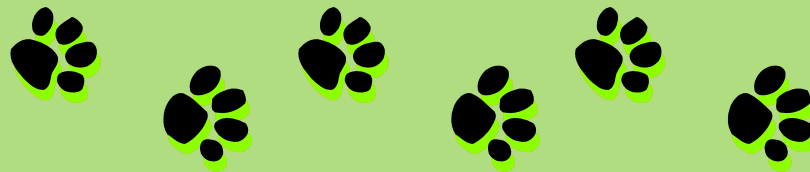
1. Earn 23.5 Credits in 4 years

23.5 Credits MINIMUM including:

- English 4
 - Social Studies 3
 - Math 4
(Must be enrolled in a math class each year of high school)
 - Science 3
 - Fine Art 1
 - Technology Ed. 1
 - Health .5
 - Physical Education .5
 - Additional Credits
 - Rigor 1
 - Financial Literacy (.5) or
Principles of Finance (1)
- TOTAL: 18.5 or 19**

2. Complete a minimum of one state approved pathway

- College Preparatory – preparation for post secondary education (college), military
- Career Technology Education – preparation for employment, college, technical school, military
- **DUAL PATHWAY COMPLETION IS RECOMMENDED!!!**



College Prep Pathway

- What electives can I take that will help me prepare myself academically for college?
- 2 credits of a world language in the same language is a minimum (Spanish, French, ASL)
- Algebra 1, Algebra 2, Geometry and an additional college prep math; **MATH MUST BE TAKEN EACH YEAR OF HIGH SCHOOL!**
- Honors and Advanced Placement (AP) courses recommended **“THINK RIGOR!”**

Career Technology Academy (CTA)

- CTA courses take 4 periods in your schedule in grades 11 and 12:
 - Grade 11 – CTA course is worth 2 credits, 1 credit for English 11 and 1 period for travel
 - Grade 12 – CTA course is worth 3 credits, one of which counts as “rigor” and 1 period for travel
 - EXCEPTION: Cosmetology/Fire & Rescue is worth 3 credits in both 11th and 12th grades and English 11 is taken at PHS

Dual Enrollment Options: (CSM & PHS)

- Requires a 2.5 minimum cumulative GPA and placement test results
- Start college transcript early
- Courses required for HS graduation are dually recorded on HS transcript and college transcript
- 50+% off tuition/free tuition
