- The PSAT is an examination created to allow students to practice for the SAT examination, the most widely accepted college admission exam.
- By taking the PSAT, students earn access to the following services offered by the CollegeBoard, at no additional cost:
 - PSAT Performance Review
 - Practice SAT Questions
 - College Search Tools
 - Scholarship Information
- For **9th** grade students interested in college, the feedback from the PSAT is a great tool to determine areas of strength and weakness and to help you to formulate a plan for your 4 years of high school.
- All **10th** grade students will be registered for the PSAT at no cost to students.
- By taking the PSAT, current **11th** grade students may qualify for scholarships. It also gives you more practice for the SAT, which most students begin taking in January or March of their junior year.
- Any student in **12th** grade who is planning on taking the SAT *after* October 15th should also register for the exam.
- Space is limited. To guarantee a seat, you must use the **Priority Registration Form**.
- To register, return the form below to your first period teacher **the cost will be \$15.00**.
