The PSAT is an examination created to allow students to practice for the SAT examination, the most widely accepted college admission exam.

For **9th** grade students interested in college, the feedback from the PSAT is a great tool to determine areas of strength and weakness and to help you to formulate a plan for your 4 years of high school.

All **10th** grade students will be registered for the PSAT at no cost to students.

By taking the PSAT, current **11th** grade students may qualify for scholarships. It also gives you more practice for the SAT, which most students begin taking in January or March of their junior year.

Any student in **12th** grade who is planning on taking the SAT *after* October 15th should also register for the exam.
